- There will also be a writing and maths workshop later on in the year.



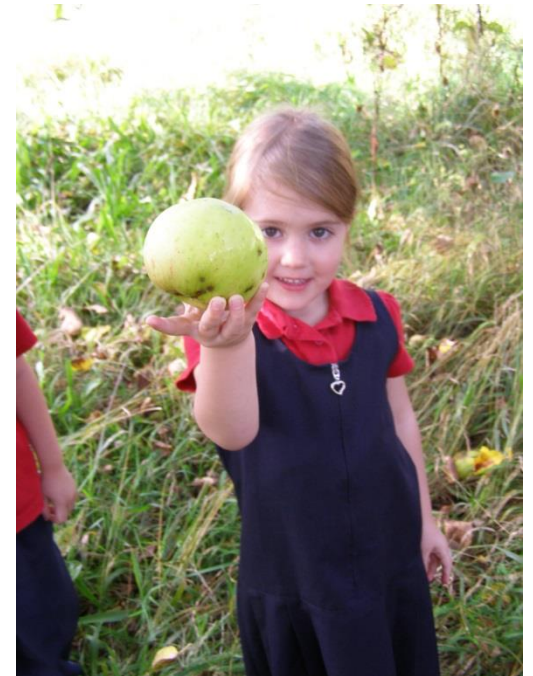
Lunchtimes

Our Sunshine Chart

- Our visual chart relates directly to the school's behaviour charter.
- All children begin the day on the sun.
- They move up to the rainbow for outstanding work or behaviour. They will receive 2 house points.
- They move down to the cloud for behaviours where they have been given a 'friendly warning'.
- The storm cloud relates to a stage 3 or 4 where behaviours are persistent or physical. In this case you will be notified and a sanction put in place.
