







Remote Learning for Apple Class 2021

Revisit If possible begin your phonics session with a revisit of previous letter sounds covered (for some children that may still be Phase 2 letter sounds, for most it will be the Phase 3 sounds beginning with j, w, v, x) You can use a range of strategies from flash cards (homemade with do), point to the letter sounds on a phonics mat or use the powerpoints – go to Phonics Activities and Resources/files/phase 2 phonics presentations or phase 3 phonic presentations We also revisit (daily) the phase 2 and 3 tricky words, again you will find useful presentations in the above folders.
