This week in history the children will be introduced to Samuel Pepys and how he played quite a significant role during and after the fire. We will be learning how to sketch him and reading some of his diary entries!

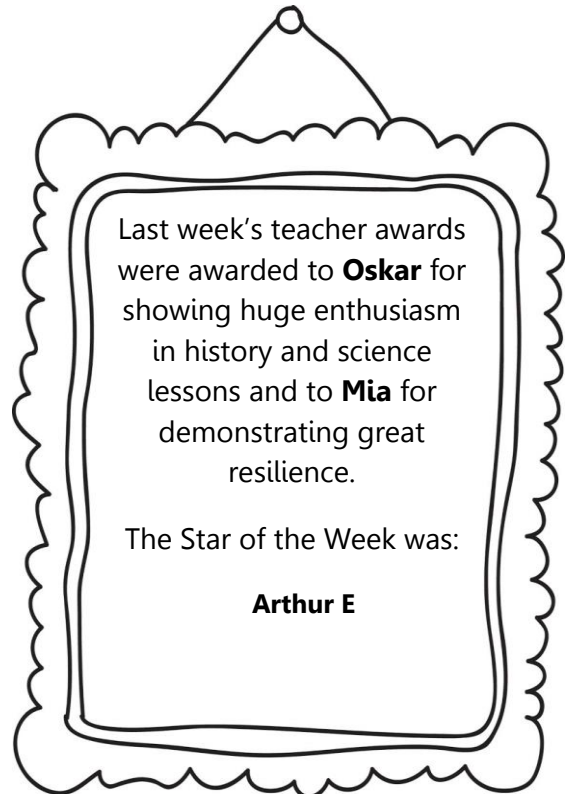
