We have had a fun week in Willow Class this week. We started our week with a great afternoon session in Mike's Meadow making shelters for mammals. The children needed to think about all the things a mammal might need in their habitat, and we discussed the types of mammals we might find in Mike's Meadow including badgers and squirrels amongst others.

Hopefully some birds will stick around when the meadow is invaded by 30 noisy children!!! We will send our Citizen Science results off to the team at The Great British Birdwatch.
