
This week we are focusing on families, please could you provide us with a photo of your child and family together, so that we can add it to our small display in the class library area. (no bigger than 5x7 please)

Phonics



Following on from this introduction to initial phonemes, we will begin to send home reading books that match these sounds.

What are we learning this week:

We will begin Drawing Club this week, starting with a old favourite 'Not Now Bernard'. The children will have some fun creating their own monster images and building homes for Bernards visiting monster!

We will be focusing on our families and where we live, with lots of discussions around who is in our family and why they are special to us. The children will draw pictures of their family members and using construction materials build their homes.

In Music the children will continue to learn about the 'pulse' or 'beat' within a song. They will revisit the songs 'Pat a cake and 1,2,3,4,5' plus learn a new song 'This Old Man'.

In PE will continue to play games that will develop the children's ability to listen and respond using whole body movements. (PE kits to be worn on Tuesdays and Thursdays)
