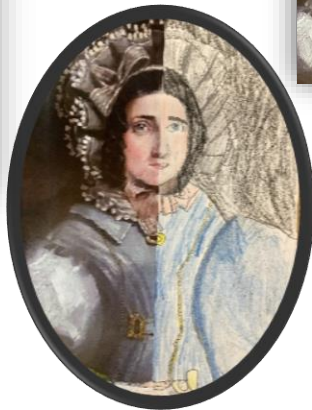


# Elm Class Newsletter
