

Phonics



The children will be introduced to a digraph this week (ck) they will learn the mantra 'A digraph is two letters one sound'

What are we learning this week:

We begin the week with Drawing Club, looking at the story 'The Colour Monster'. This story reflects the theme of kindness and encourages the children to reflect upon their emotions using colours. Being Kind to each other, and emphasising our pledges 'Kind words, Kind actions and Kind heart' will be reinforced throughout the week.

In maths we will be looking at making patterns using a repeating method, the children will have a range of different resources to practise this skill and tap into their creativity.

In Computing we have been learning about what a computer is, this week we will introduce the children to the idea of using a device to take photos. We will show the children how they can do this an upload into their Seesaw folders.

Finally, it is Hello yellow day on Friday. The children will come in dressed in yellow, to support Mental Health Day. With the class we will continue to learn about what makes us happy and healthy. I hope to take the class into Mike's Meadow for some tree bathing!!
