Maths: Multiplication and Division

Linking multiplying and dividing 3 and 6 times table facts and using knowledge to problem solve.

Times Tables: Children continue to practise learning their $\times 2$, $\times 3$, $\times 4$, $\times 5$, $\times 10$ times tables using TTRS and by daily step counting (recalling and chanting the number facts).
