Dear Parents and Carers,

We've had another busy week in Hazel Class. Here's a snapshot of what we've been learning:

Maths

In Maths, the children have been developing their understanding of 2D and 3D shapes. They have focused on problem-solving and reasoning, practising how to explain their answers clearly and using correct mathematical language to show their thinking.

Writing

In Writing, we began exploring portal stories. We discussed how these stories involve a character travelling from the real world into a different or magical world through a "portal." The children identified key features of portal stories, such as contrasting worlds and the changes the character experiences in these worlds.

Science

In Science, we took part in interactive experiments to investigate how sounds are made. The children learned that sounds are created by vibrations, exploring this through hands-on activities that encouraged curiosity and discussion.

PE

In PE, we have been honing our throwing skills in athletics, focusing on accuracy, control and technique. This is in preparation for our upcoming Sports Day.
