We've had another busy week in Hazel Class.

Maths

In Maths this week, we recapped our understanding of triangles, quadrilaterals and other polygons, as well as revisiting key features of 2D and 3D shapes. The children have been working hard to apply this knowledge to problem-solving and reasoning questions, explaining their thinking clearly and confidently.

Writing

In Writing, the children wrote a discussion text exploring arguments for the Stone Age and the Iron Age. We had some thoughtful debates in class, with pupils sharing ideas, listening carefully to others and using persuasive language to support their viewpoints.

Reading

We are enjoying our class text *Stig of the Dump*, which links perfectly to our Stone Age topic. The children have been engaged and curious, making great links between the story and our history learning.

Times Tables

Please continue to encourage lots of practice of times tables up to $12\times$. This will really support your child's confidence and fluency ahead of the Multiplication Tables Check, which takes place from **Monday 1st June to Friday 12th June**.
