Dear Parents and Carers,

In our writing lessons in the last week of term, the children wrote imaginative portal stories, showing their creativity and understanding of the genre. In their writing, they included a magical or mysterious portal that transported their characters to a new world, rich descriptions of the contrasting settings between the real world and the fantasy land, and exciting adventures or problems that the characters had to overcome after travelling through the portal.

In maths, children enjoyed creating their very own fraction exhibits in maths during the last week of term 5. They recapped their fraction learning by designing their own “museum exhibits.” Each child or group created a display that represented fractions in a visual or practical way, such as fraction pizzas, fraction walls, shaded shapes, or real-life examples. They also represented fractions of amounts using resources we borrowed from the Year 1 class, Cherry. The classroom was then transformed into a “museum,” where pupils walked around, observed each other’s work, and discussed what they saw.



We were also very lucky to work with the artist Julie Starks. With her support, we created our own crustacean sculptures using willow branches and recycled plastic. This made our artwork both creative and sustainable.
