We have had a mix of practical indoor and outdoor learning opportunities this week.

In science, we created our mini water cycles so we could understand the 4 stages of the water cycle: Collection, evaporation, condensation and precipitation. There was some great discussion around the separate stages of the cycle.



In science, the children also created a model of the digestive system. We used a potato masher to mash bananas to recreate the part the teeth play in the digestive system. A plastic bag represented the stomach and vinegar for stomach acid. Finally, we used tights for the large and small intestines. It was a messy but fun and engaging learning activity!
